JUNE IS PRIDE MONTH

48.3% of lesbian women & 61.1% of bisexual women have experienced rape, physical violence, and stalking by an intimate partner at some point in their lifetime, compared to 35% of heterosexual women.

Nearly half of all bisexual men and 4 in 10 gay men have experienced some form of sexual violence other than rape in their lifetime

Many LGBTQ+ survivors do not report due to fear of bias and lack of resources.
