## LEGISLATION SPOTLIGHT: PROTECTIVE ORDERS V. PEACE ORDERS

In Maryland, protective and peace orders are forms of civil protection.

Read below for the descriptions and applications of each order.

**Protection Order (PO):** A protection order applies in situations of domestic violence, child abuse, rape, sexual assault, or spousal abuse. PO's apply to those in intimate relationships, familial relationships, or other domestic relationships.

**Peace Order:** A peace order applies in situations with others persons where the petitioner is not related to the respondent by blood or participating in an intimate relationship. Peace orders address stalking, trespassing, harassment, destruction of property, and other ordeals.



#### COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION SPOTLIGHT: CHILDREN IN NEED

**Who Are They?:** Children in Need (CIN) of Washington County serves disadvantaged children and their families.



What Do They Do?: Children in Need distributes basic necessities like clothing, shoes, books, toiletries, and baby items to children and families affected by homelessness, domestic violence, natural disasters, and other life challenges.
